





You will be using Quick Selections, Layers and Layer Masks, Adjustment Layers and Blending Modes

January Technique—Rim lighting

- When the main light is behind a subject
- Exposes the outline of the subject with light
- Highlights contours of a subject
- Can create a dramatic and mysterious effect



February Technique – Editing for HDR

- Dynamic range is simply the range of the lightest tones to the darkest tones within a photo.
- High dynamic range (HDR) is when the image has high contrast, i.e. areas that are very light and very dark.
- Photos can be edited to lighten shadows and/or darken highlights to reveal the details that were visible to your eye. Also, an individual area can be selected and adjusted for level of brightness.
- Depending on the scene, you may not be able to fully recover details in shadows, highlights or both.


