

# Tips for shooting near water

## Less than ideal images

- Too much or boring sky/water
- Crooked horizon
- No interesting subject
- Unimpressive waves



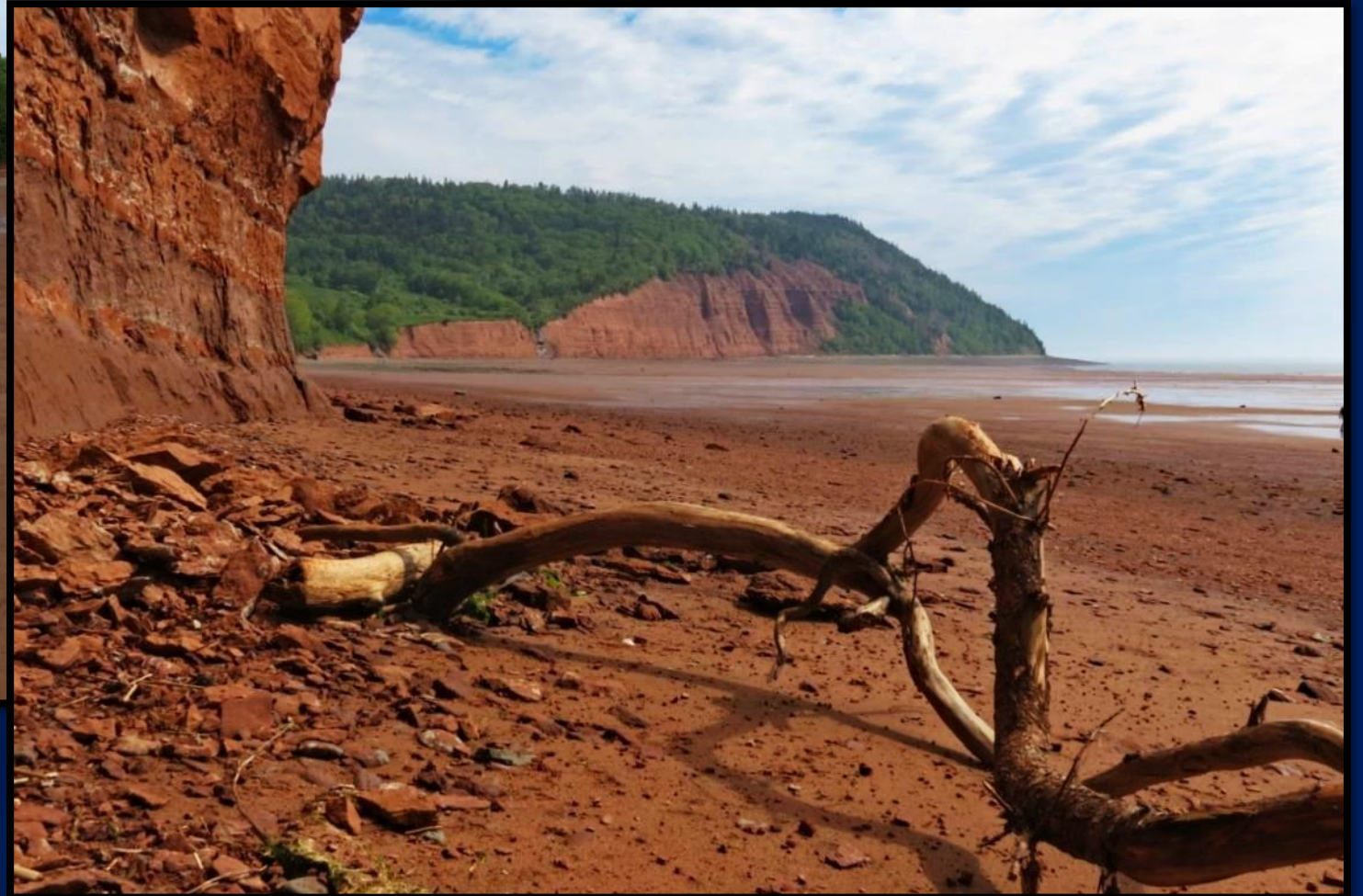
## Tips for better pics near water:

- Use in-camera display to line up horizon or edit afterwards
- Use foreground to break up sand, sea, sky
- Add objects of interest - people, birds, boats, etc.
- Look for curves, lines and textures
- Get low to shoot waves, rocks, etc. Compress empty areas.
- Try long exposures
- Plan ahead for sunrise/sunset



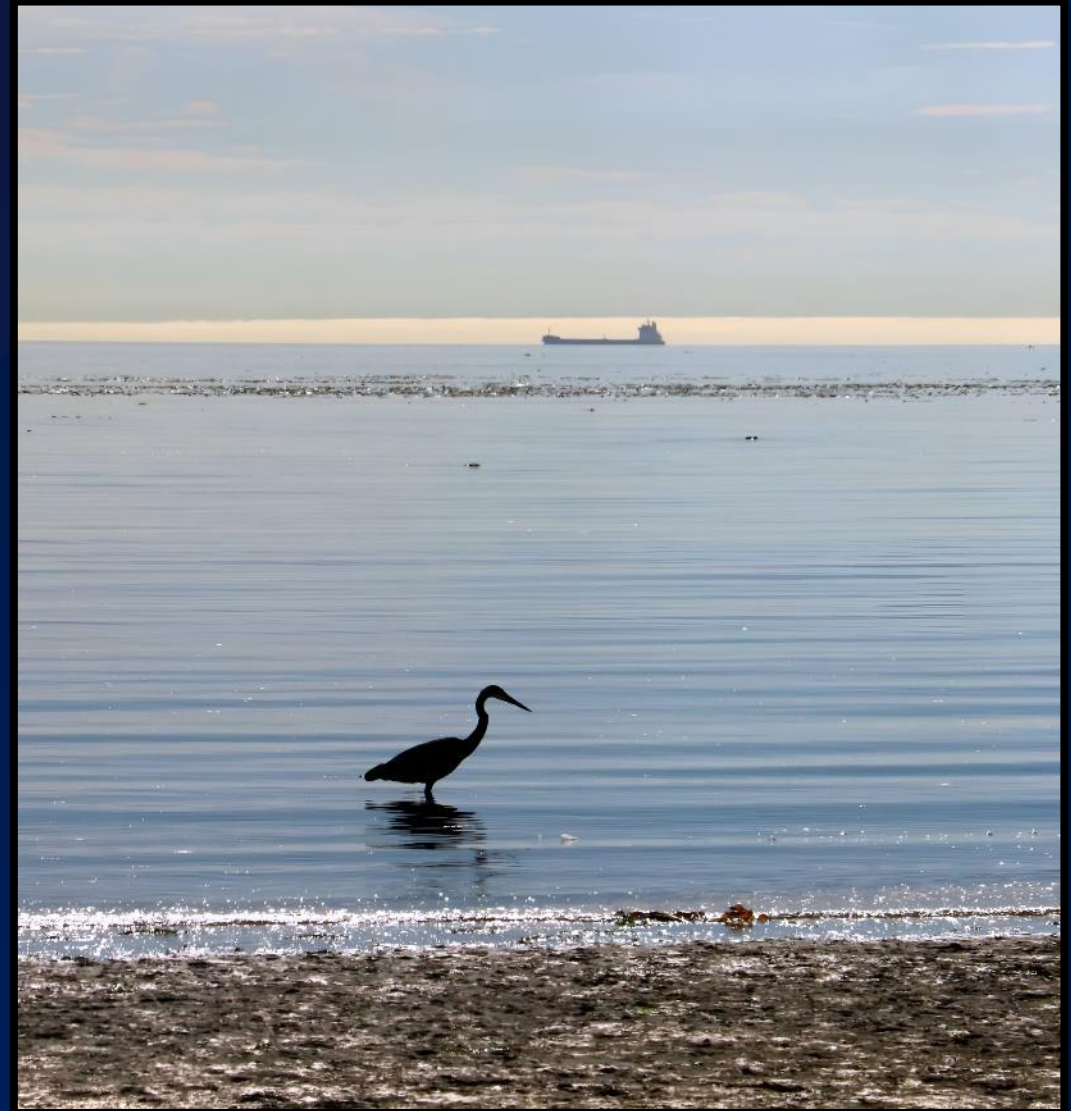


Look for foreground





Look for birds

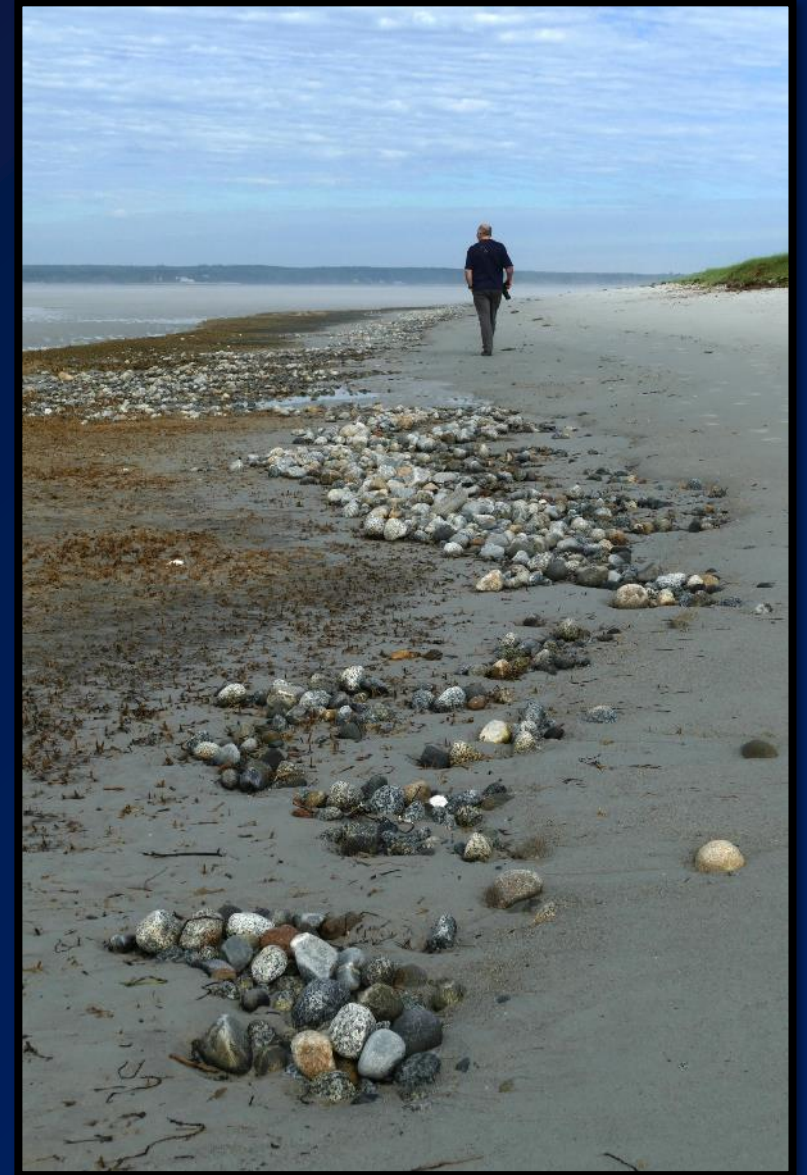


Add human interest
